

Teen Central Volunteer Staff expectations

You, as a teen central volunteer, is what makes this ministry successful. Your investment of time and energy into the lives of our youth can have a huge impact. Their perception of Christ is seen through your actions and words. Their outlook on life and their current situation is influenced greatly by your words of encouragement, affirmation, and love. In order to maintain a successful program at Teen Central we have developed a few Volunteer expectations to help you be effective in your personal ministry and to aid in the collective ministry of Teen Central.

1. Commit to volunteering one evening per week for one full year.
2. Evaluate your experience with the Program Director twice a year.
3. Be aware that you are a Christian mentor/role model and all behavior, attitudes, and actions must exemplify Godly character.
4. Arrive at the Center 10 minutes before open time for a time of prayer and information. Remain after the center closes to discuss the evening and help clean up.
5. Find a replacement if you are unable to attend your specified day/time and communicate this with the Program Director in advance. (see staff directory)
6. Be willing to help staff special events
7. Attend training events
8. Be an advocate for the Center among the community and your Church.
9. Attend the drop-in time with an attitude of serving.
10. Pray for the center and our youth
